## **5 DAYS TO DINE IN DOLLY PARTON'S HOMETOWN** **Find Unique Eateries in Sevierville, TN**

Nestled in the foothills of Great Smoky Mountains National Park, Sevierville, Tennessee is known as Dolly Parton's hometown and the center of upscale outlet shopping in the Great Smoky Mountains area (which includes Pigeon Forge and Gatlinburg, TN). Sevierville and her sister cities see millions of visitors each year, many of whom never venture far from the main Parkway for their meals. Only the true foodies know about many of these hidden gustatory gems.

### **DAY 1**

***English Mountain Trout Farm & Grill*** – Catch your own lunch at this unique restaurant where “You hook ‘em, We cook ‘em” is the motto. Don't like fish? That's okay – their menu includes a variety of delicious meals – from chicken to burgers and even salads. All foods are prepared fresh when you order so prepare for a leisurely (and delicious) meal.

***The Applewood Farmhouse Restaurant*** – A 1920s farmhouse serves as the anchor restaurant for this working apple orchard complex. Every meal begins with fresh apple fritters, apple butter and their signature Applewood Julep (a non-alcoholic fruit drink). After your meal, tour the complex and watch as baked goods, candy, wine and ice cream are made before your eyes.
