



Exploring the Smoky Mountains & Sevierville, Tennessee

Day 1

Your Great Smoky Mountain vacation begins in [Dolly Parton's](#) hometown, **Sevierville, Tennessee**.

Get the outdoor adventure started with a trip across one of America's longest swinging bridges at [Foxfire Mountain](#). This welcoming attraction is home to thrilling zip line courses, a 60-foot climbing wall, and hiking adventures. Kind, leashed dogs are welcome as well to enjoy the property with family and friends.

Depart for spelunking through one of America's most spectacular caves and great natural attractions, [Forbidden Caverns](#). This hour-long guided tour is an easy walk taking visitors deep underground to learn the cave's history as a shelter for Eastern Woodland Indians and a hideout for moonshiners.

In the afternoon, tour the [Apple Barn Complex](#), taste delicious fruit-based wines and hard ciders, and enjoy homemade ice cream at [The Apple Valley Creamery](#).

Save room for a down-home dinner at the [Applewood Farmhouse Restaurant](#), where every farm fresh meal begins with warm apple fritters and chilled (non-alcoholic) Applewood Julep.

After dinner, visit one of the city's **Moonshine** distilleries, including [Shine Girl](#), [Tennessee Legend Distillery](#), or [Tennessee Shine Co.](#) for a sip of White Lightnin', better known as moonshine.

Finish a summer's night on the mountaintop at [SkyLand Ranch](#). Take a peaceful chairlift ride to spectacular views, great food and entertainment – plus meet the resident miniature animals! Opt to ride the southeast's longest mountain coaster, *The Wild Stallion*, or even book a ride on The Safari Hayride at SkyLand Ranch.

Day 2

Fuel up for a day in the great outdoors at [Flapjack's Pancake Cabin](#), where traditional breakfast skillet and Southern Pecan Pancakes receive rave reviews.

Take in the shopping at [Tanger Outlets Sevierville](#) where you'll find over 100 high-end stores ranging from Kate Spade to Huk. While there, make plans to visit [XPERIA: Ocean Journey](#), an immersive undersea cinematic experience that's one-of-a-kind.

Head to [historic downtown Sevierville](#) for boutique shopping and meals at chef-driven restaurants. Snap a group photo with the [bronze statue of Dolly Parton](#) and book a dinner reservation at [The Appalachian](#), [Trotter's Whole Hog BBQ](#), or [Seasons 101](#). Afterward, make plans to enjoy the nightlife at [The Pines Downtown](#) – which is housed in the former Pines Theater where Dolly played her first paying gig at the age of ten.

Day 3

Enjoy breakfast at the [Five Oaks Farm Kitchen](#) located on the Five Oaks Farm. Then walk up the hill to [Ogle Brothers General Store](#) for an authentic shopping experience.

Take flight at the [Tennessee Museum of Aviation](#). A hidden gem, this attraction features authentic flyable warbird aircraft, including two flyable P-47 Thunderbolts, and a relic from the U.S.S. Arizona. While there, be on the lookout for impromptu flights by these amazing aircraft. Find even more history at [Titanic Museum Attraction](#) where you'll enjoy an emotional and educational tribute to the 2,208 passengers that sailed aboard the Titanic.

Just down the road, Dolly Parton's [Dollywood](#) theme park is a truly special experience. Located only a few minutes from downtown Sevierville, Dollywood has award winning roller coasters, shows, and authentic Appalachian mountain crafts. Spend the afternoon there or make plans to stay a few extra days and enjoy all the park has to offer.
