



4 Days of Fun in Sevierville, Tennessee

Day 1:

Arrive midday and stop in at the world's largest [Buc-ee's](#)! This mega gas station and convenience store is iconic for its BBQ, assortment of snack goods, and Buc-ee the Beaver themed merchandise. After stocking up, check-in to your Sevierville accommodations. Whether choosing a canvas glamping tent, waterpark resort, luxurious cabin, or fun-filled treehouse, your lodging can be just as much fun as the rest of your vacation.

Begin your Smoky Mountain visit with adventure. Sign up for a [zip line excursion](#) through the foothills or go [white water rafting](#) on the Pigeon River's Class III and IV rapids. Outdoor enthusiasts will also enjoy [fishing](#) on the area's lakes and streams, which are home to world-class smallmouth bass fishing.

Elevate your stay with a visit to [SkyLand Ranch](#), a mountaintop ranch experience featuring miniature animals, live entertainment, food, shopping, activities, and plenty of amazing views. Guests can also enjoy The Safari Hayride experience and ride the southeast's longest mountain coaster, The Wild Stallion.

There you'll visit the nature museum and view an informative film about the park before you begin to explore more than 800 miles of maintained hiking trails.

For dinner, enjoy southern cooking at its finest at [Applewood Farmhouse Restaurant](#). This historic farmhouse is located on a working apple orchard and serves up southern cooking. After dinner, stroll through the [Apple Barn Complex](#) where you can watch cooks frying apple pies, candy makers drawing taffy and sample delicious hard ciders.

Tonight, get competitive with a friendly game of duckpin bowling and refreshing drinks at [The Pines Downtown](#). This newly reimagined entertainment destination is in the old Pines Theater, where Dolly played her first paying gig at the age of 10.

Depart for [Dollywood](#), named for Sevierville's hometown girl, Dolly Parton. Spend the day enjoying live entertainment (over 40 live shows performed daily), award-winning thrill rides, delicious meals, shopping, authentic mountain craft demonstrations and more.

Later that day, schedule time for shopping in Sevierville – the shopping capital of the Smokies.
